Reading - 2022/2023

How do our classrooms promote reading?

- EYFS & KS1 – inviting class library areas stocked with quality texts of different genres
- KS2 – class library areas (small scale due to classroom size)
- Reading for pleasure display in the classroom (Pie Corbett's Reading Spine)
- Author of the half term display and copies of the books for the children to read
- Reading over the year display – identifies which books year groups will be reading over the year (this is also added to throughout the year)
- Current class read display

What reading sessions do we provide for our children?

Guided Reading

- YR-KS1
2 x Little Wandle Reading Practice Sessions per week
 1. Decoding
 2. Prosody and Comprehension
- Y2-Y6
Independent reading tasks (VIPERS / question mats / comprehensions)
- KS2 - 1 x Whole Class Guided Reading Session per week (VIPERS)

1:1 Reading

- Y1 – Y3, all children to read to an adult at least once per week
- Y4 – Y6, all children to be heard at least once every 2 weeks.
- Target 20% of each class – to be heard by an adult in the classroom at least 3 x per week.

Daily English lessons

English lessons are planned and supported through the use of a text, linked to a topic where possible but not necessary, quality texts are the priority.

How do we promote reading at home?

- Reading Rucksack
- R-Y2 - Sharing book & eBook (decodable)
- Phonics/Reading workshops for parents/carers
- Termly Reading Breakfasts
- Reading challenges (e.g-Summer Reading Challenge)
- Dojo - communication with parents/carers
- Reading Celebration Assembly
- Certificates in celebration assembly
- Golden book

How do we support parents with reading?

- Reading and phonics workshops for the parents
- Provide parents with question stems and further advice for 'book talk'
- EYFS – Bedtime Stories
- Signpost parents to adult courses that are being ran in the local area to support with reading

How do we promote reading for pleasure? What reading incentives do we offer?

- Brand new school library
- DEAR (Drop Everything And Read) weekly – Children to independently read a book of their choice for 10 minutes (Take 10 to read initiative)
- Dedicated story time
 - EYFS - 3 x day
 - KS1 – daily (using a separate text, not current class read)
 - KS2 – daily (class read, guided reading texts, separate text)

- Poetry theme days
- EYFS, KS1 & KS2 – Reading Rucksack - Each week a child who has excelled within reading will be chosen to take the 'Reading Rucksack' home.
- Whole school reading celebration assembly each half term
